The first of the series: Tales of David Sullivan, *Windmaster's Bane* was originally published in 1986 as an Avon paperback. This collector's edition has been updated and re-written lightly by the author, but retains the charm and energy of the original. New illustrations by the author enliven the part pages. The new cover is from a painting by Val and Ron Lindahn, whose images have graced work by Piers Anthony, Isaac Asimov, magazines and movies.
